Directions to Delta Kits

From 1-5 North or South:

Take Exit 195B. Stay on the expressway (Beltline Road) to the very end (approximately 9 miles) Turn LEFT on W. 11th Ave. Proceed a little over 1 mile EAST. Turn LEFT at Bailey Hill Road. Delta Kits is on your LEFT.

From Eugene Airport:

Exit Airport, which will bring you on to Green Hill Rd. Go straight. (You will see a sign that says left Eugene, do not turn left) Continue straight on Green Hill Rd. to West 11th Ave. Turn LEFT, go approximately 3 miles. Take a LEFT on Bailey Hill Road; Delta Kits is on your LEFT.
